Comrades,

As Officers, Members of the Council of Administration, Past State Commanders, Chairman of Committee, Committee Members and Members of the Department of New York Veterans of Foreign Wars you should not speak to the news media as an official or unofficial spokesperson of the Department of New York Veterans of Foreign Wars without prior clearance from the Department Commander or Department Adjutant. All inquiries from the media should be referred to the Department Adjutant.

Should a Department Officer, Members of the Council of Administration, Past State Commanders, Chairman of Committee, Committee Members and Members of the Department of New York Veterans of Foreign Wars receive a media inquiry, he or she should respond: "I have no authority to respond to your request." You should refer your question to the Department Adjutant.

Further, the Department of New York Veterans of Foreign Wars recognizes the growing importance of online social media networks as a communications tool. This addresses Department Officers, Members of the Council of Administration, Past State Commander, Chairman of Committee, Committee Members and Members of the Department of New York use of networks including social networks, online forums, personal websites, web logs (blogs), wikipedia, and any other kid of social media. Examples of social media applications are LinkedIn, Facebook, Myspace, Wikipedia, YouTube, Twitter, Yelp, Flickr, Second Life, Yahoo groups, WordPress, and Zoom Info. These examples are not an exhaustive or exclusive list.

The internet and social media can be powerful tools in shaping public thinking about the Department of New York Veterans of Foreign Wars, its department Officers, Members of the Council of Administration, Past State Commander, Chairman of Committee, Committee Members and Members of the Department of New York, business associates, and mission. The FW recognized the importance of our Department Officers or Chairman Joining the online conversation helping Veterans of Foreign Wars' advocacy efforts through knowledgeable and responsible interaction in social media.

These guidelines will help you make appropriate decisions about the content of your blogs, personal websites, postings on social media sites, and postings on video or picture sharing sites. These guidelines will help you open a respectful, knowledgeable interaction with people on the Internet. They

also protect the privacy, confidentiality, and interest of the Veterans of Foreign Wars and our current and potential Department Officers or Chairman, employees, members, affiliates, supporters, business associates and other constituents.

These guidelines will help you make appropriate decisions about the content of your blogs, personal websites, postings on social media sites, and postings on video or picture sharing sites. These guidelines will help you open a respectful, knowledgeable interaction with people on the Internet. They also protect the privacy, confidentiality, and interest of the Veterans of Foreign Wars and our current and potential Department t Officers or Chairman, employees, members, affiliates, supporters, business associates and other constituents.

Guidelines

- Know and follow related Veterans of Foreign Wars policies including Acceptable Use of the Internet, Electronic Monitoring, Use of Facilities and Equipment, Employee Code of Responsibility, Employee Expectations, and Speaking with the Media. This policy does not waive, modify or alter any other policy or legal duty applicable to employees and their communications or dissemination of information.
- Respect copyright, fair use, and financial disclosure laws.
- Department officers, Members of the Council of Administration, Past State commanders, Chairman, of Committee, Committee Members and Members of the Department of New York are personally responsible for the content they publish online. Recognize that what you write can become public information. Your participation and communications over the Internet may place you and your communications into a social media network with or without your knowledge or you may provide explicit or implicit authorization. Department Officers or Chairman remain responsible for their communications regardless of the scope or actual knowledge regarding the use or dissipation of their communications.
- You may not share information that is confidential and proprietary about the Veterans of Foreign Wars. This includes information about trademarks, sales, finances, number of products sold, and number of employees, organizational strategy, and any other information that has not been publicly release by the Veterans of Foreign Wars. If you have nay question about whether information has been released publicly or doubts of any kind, speak with your director/manager or the Communications department before releasing information. The Veterans of Foreign Wars logo and trademarks may not be used without explicit permission in writing from the Veterans of Foreign Wars. This is to prevent the appearance that you speak for or represent the Veterans of Foreign Wars officially.
- Speak respectfully about the Veterans of Foreign Wars and our current policies, employees, customers, partners, supporters and members. Do not engage in name calling or behavior that will reflect negatively on the Veterans of Foreign Wars' image or reputation. Note that the use of copyrighted materials, unfounded or derogatory statements, or misrepresentation is not viewed favorable by the Veterans of Foreign Wars and can result in disciplinary action up to and including employee termination.

- The Veterans of Foreign Wars encourages you to write knowledgeably, accurately and to use appropriate professionalism. When discussing the Veterans of Foreign Wars in your personal capacity, use a disclaimer such as "The postings on this site are my own and do not necessarily represent the views of the Veterans of Foreign Wars." If you are developing a site or writing a blog that will mention our organization, business associates, or employees let your director/manger know. Your director/manager may choose to visit your site.
- Honor the privacy rights of our current employees by seeking their permission before writing about or displaying internal organization happenings that might be considered a breach of their privacy and confidentiality.

Your Legal Liability

- Recognize that you are legally liable for anything your write or present t online.
- Department Officers or Chairman can be disciplined by the Veterans of Foreign Wars for commentary, content, or images that are defamatory, pornographic, proprietary, harassing and libelous, that can create a hostile professional environment, or that are a breach of Veterans of Foreign Wars policies, duty of loyalty, common law or statutory law.
- You can also be sued by Veterans of Foreign Wars employees, business associates, supporters, members and any individual or company that views your commentary, content, or images as defamatory, pornographic, proprietary, harassing, libelous or creating a hostile work environment.

District Commander

Although attendance is improving at District Meetings and Conventions we must continue to do our due diligence to make sure that we do not lose the momentum that has been started. As Department Commander, I must direct all Districts in the State of New York to follow the National By-Laws and Manual of Procedure as they apply to your Districts without exception as well as provide guidance on follow-on action for failure to comply.

Again, this year we will be assigning a Department Line Officer to attend each of your meetings for the purpose of providing instructions and to bring feedback to the Department Officers on how we may better assist at the District level.

- All Districts shall conduct a minimum of two (2) meetings annually unless otherwise prescribed in the National By-Laws and Manual of Procedures.
- 2. All Districts shall conduct one Convention each year.
- 3. All Districts shall take attendance at the beginning of each Meeting or Convention and record the number of the Post, the name of the representative and their membership number.
- 4. Immediately following the roll call of Posts the <u>Adjutant shall announce</u> if a quorum is present (a quorum shall be not less than one (1) delegate each from fifty (50) percent of Posts in the District).
- 5. The District Commander <u>may not excuse</u> a Post representative from a District Meeting or Convention; however, during a period of inclement weather where travel would jeopardize the safety and well being of attendees, the District Commander does have the authority to reschedule said meeting or Convention.
- 6. A Post representative must be present for the entire duration of a District Meeting or Convention. If the Post representative leaves prior to the close of the meeting the Post will not be given credit for attending the District Meeting or Convention.
- 7. A District Meeting and Convention should be conducted, when possible, at a Post centrally located within the District to provide each Post the opportunity to attend in a location somewhere within a reasonable commuting distance from their Post.
- 8. The District Commander has the option of offering remote access for all meetings and Conventions by the use of electronic means such as Zoom, Net Meeting, etc. if he or she so desires; however, the State Commander can require attendance by electronic means under special conditions if warranted. If remote access is authorized by the District Commander, attendees will be required to be present for the meeting using video either through the use of a laptop or desktop computer, I-Pad or phone provided attendees can be seen on the screen by all attendees at the meeting. Use of any electronic device where video is not available is not authorized.

9. The District Commander shall ensure official written notification is sent to all Post Commanders, County Council Commanders, Past District Commanders and Past State Commanders within their District by US Mail not less than 10 days prior to the scheduled meeting date nor more than 30 days prior to the meeting date. The written notification must include the date, time, and location of the meeting as well as whether the meeting or Convention will be offered by electronic means.

The District Commander shall ensure that a copy of the meeting notification and a copy of the mailing list are forwarded to Department Headquarters within 10 days of the meeting date.

- 10. The District Commander shall <u>within 10 days</u> of each Meeting or Convention ensure that a copy of the minutes of the Meeting or Convention and a copy of the attendance record signed by the Adjutant is sent to Department Headquarters.
- 11. The District shall <u>within 10 days</u> of each Meeting or Convention investigate why a Post was not represented and report the reason to Department Headquarters using the attached form. The reply should provide the detailed circumstances why the Post failed to provide a representative at the meeting or Convention. Additionally, as District Commander, you will make a recommendation as to the corrective action that should be initiated by the State Commander for failure to provide a representative and circumstances to justify that recommendation.
- 12. Following the recommendation of the District Commander, administrative or disciplinary action may be initiated by the State Commander to include but not limited to:
 - a. No action
 - b. Letter of Warning
 - c. Letter of Censure
 - d. Suspension of the Post Charter and placed under Administrative Control
 - e. Disciplinary Action under Article IX
 - f. Removal from Office
 - g. Other action as deemed appropriate by the State Commander

For information:

ARTICLE IV—DISTRICTS

Sec. 403—Regular, Special and Committee Meetings; Convention; Quorum; Authorized Attendees.

<u>Regular Meeting.</u> Unless otherwise provided for in Department By-Laws, Districts shall **hold at least two (2) regular meetings** each year for purposes as prescribed in the Manual of Procedure.

Special meetings will be called in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Manual of Procedure. No business shall be transacted at any special meeting except that for which the meeting was called.

Informational Meeting: The District Bylaws may be written to include additional informational meetings or the District Commander may schedule additional informational meetings if he or she desires; however, these meetings will not be mandatory and no business may be conducted.

Convention. Each District shall hold an annual District Convention for the purpose of electing District officers and for the transaction of business; such Convention to be held not less than ten (10) days nor more than seventy-five (75) days prior to the convening of the Department Convention.

Quorum. The minimum number of delegates required to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at a regular meeting, special meeting or District Convention shall be not less than one (1) delegate each from fifty (50) percent of Posts in the District.

Authorized Attendees. Any member, not a member of the District may attend a District meeting or Convention; however, they shall have no voice in business discussions unless requested by the Commander, and shall have no voting privileges. Those attending on official business shall be recognized by the Commander for the conduct of business.
