Allan E. Davenport received his eligibility to the Veterans of Foreign Wars serving in Vietnam with the United States Marine Corps. Serving one thirteen-month tour with two six-month extensions. Earning the Combat Action Ribbon, President Unit Citation, Marine Corps Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Medal, Vietnam Service Medal w/4 Bronze Stars, Vietnam Gallantry Cross Unit Citation, Vietnam Civil Actions Unit Citation, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, and from the State of New York, the State of New York Medal for Merit, and State of New York Conspicuous Service Star.

Joined the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1019 on October 10, 1980, as a new member. Served as Post Commander three times, All State every time, once Captain, and another time All American, served Post Quartermaster sixteen times, thirteen times on the All-State team.
