Commander George S. Smith was elected State Commander of the Department of New York Veterans of Foreign Wars on June 29, 1985 in Buffalo, New York. George Smith served with the United States Navy during World War II in the South Pacific.

He served as Commander of Post 53 in Jamestown, the largest VFW Post in the State of New York during 1955-56, Chautauqua County Commander in 1957-58 and District #6 Commander in 1967-68. Has served as Chairman of various committees in the Department of New York and on National Civil Service Employment, National Security, Americanism and Legislative Committee.
